



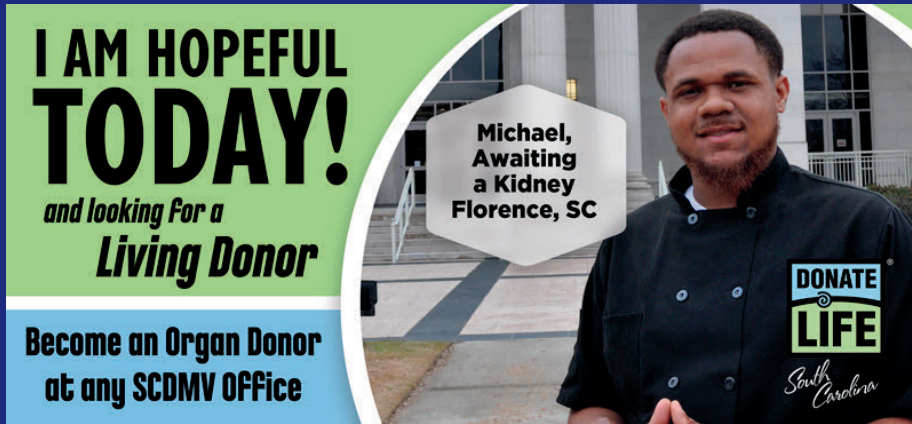

Within a week of the COVID-19 shutdown, DLSC partnered with DHEC and Sharing Hope SC to reach out to the governor's office to lessen the turnaround time to 24 hours for Covid testing results. Gratefully, this enactment for the state significantly affected the ability of organ transplantations to continue unencumbered by the typical 2-3 months testing response timeframe. As a result, 2020 brought marked changes by increased donor awareness, and lives changed through the "Gift of Life".

But, most importantly, I extend my grateful appreciation and love to all donors and donor families who have said "YES" to donation.

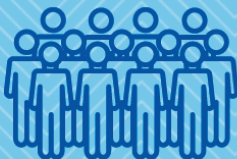

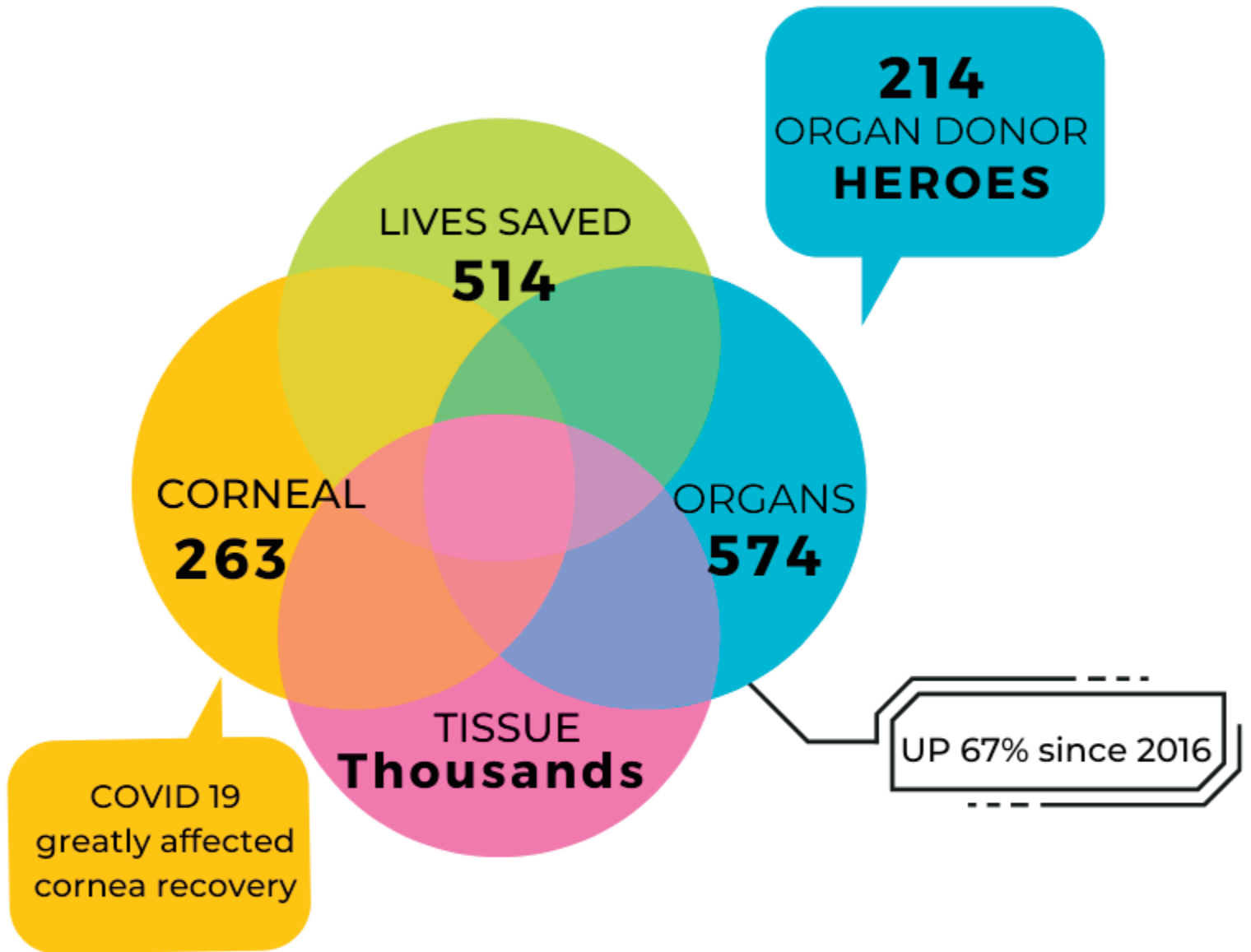

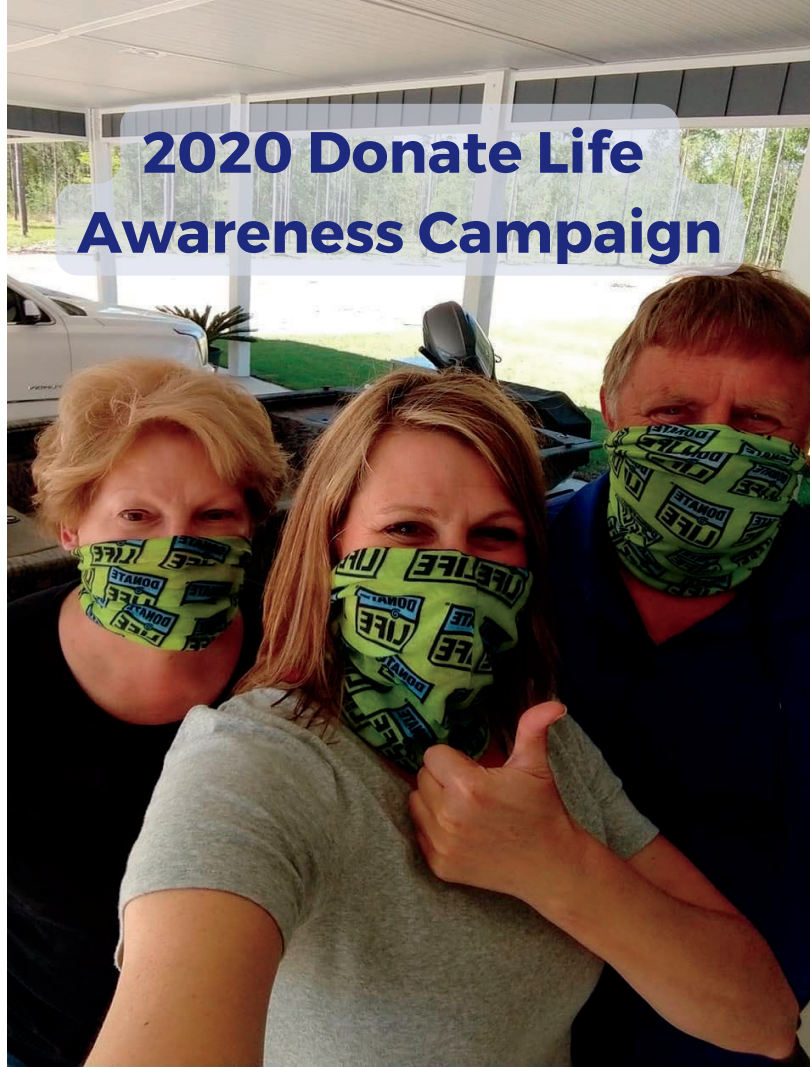
