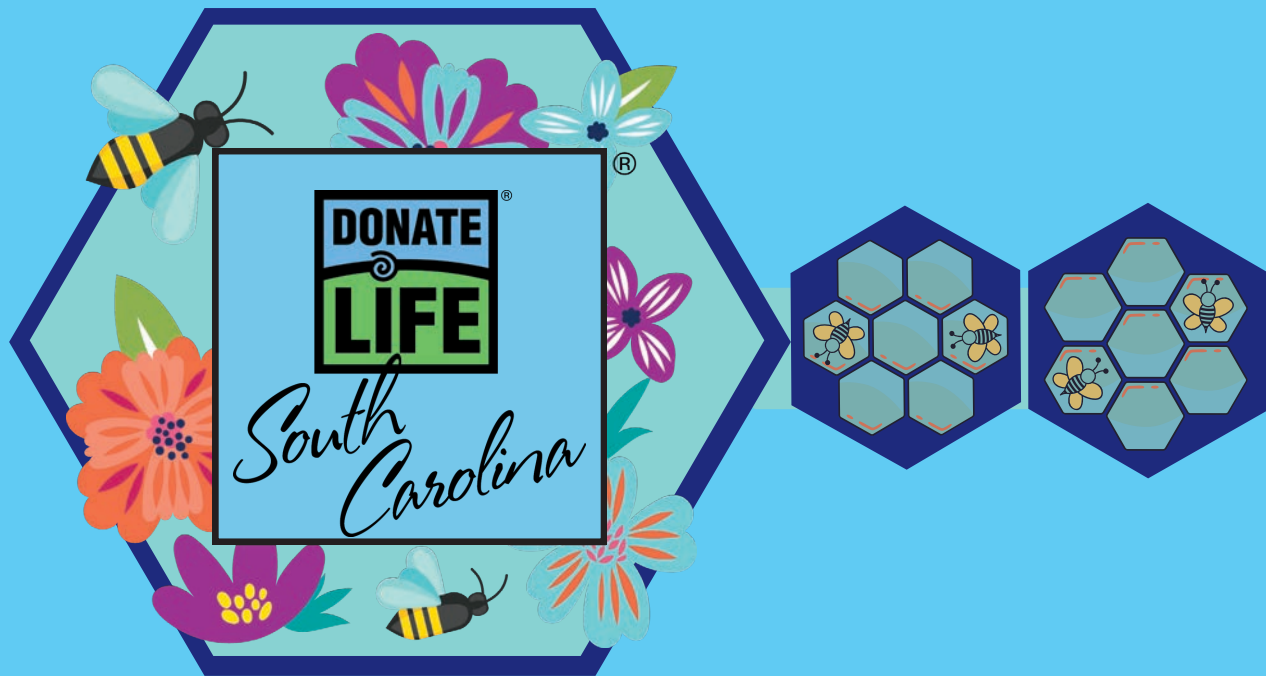

Message from Executive Director
